MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON APRIL 11, 2022

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4583 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

Chairman Vito Yeropoli asked everyone present to recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Mark Sackin, and Vito Yeropoli. Also, present were Solicitor Lou Perrotta, Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, and Police Chief Robert Sipe. Absent was Supervisor Gary Pezzuolo.

Yeropoli asked for any guest speakers. Resident Jill Bissett thanked the maintenance department for their work during the recent storms. Ms. Bissett questioned the plan for the road improvements. Yeropoli explained the Township has 51 miles of roads to maintain. The budget for paving in 2023 is \$150,000. Gregg noted that paving and tar and chipping is in the plans. Yeropoli noted the County is trying to remove the \$5 - \$10 fee per vehicle registration which is in part monies that filter to the townships for grants. Yeropoli encouraged residents to voice opinions that this funding sources is needed in the Township. Ms. Bissett asked for signs on Evergreen for no trucks. Sackin noted stopping a driver this morning who couldn't speak or read English. Yeropoli noted a sign would be installed but likely will not make a difference.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the March 14, 2023 meeting minutes and the motion was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.
