MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JUNE 13, 2023

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4583 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

Chairman Vito Yeropoli asked everyone present to recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Gary Pezzuolo, Mark Sackin, and Vito Yeropoli. Also, present were Solicitor Lou Perrotta, and Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe.

Yeropoli asked for any guest speakers. Resident Jill Bissett was following up on semi-trucks being prohibited on Evergreen and update on paving for Graham Road. DelPrincipe and Yeropoli noted this will be addressed later in the meeting. Second, was PA Police Trooper John O'Day who was making an annual presentation with a report on support given from the State Police in Mahoning Township for 54 calls over 6 months. Pezzuolo thanked the officer for their presence in the township and in particular noted resident state trooper Darren Vizyak is often seen patrolling.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the May 9, 2023 meeting minutes and the motion was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

TOWNSHIP REPORTS were given as follows:

ZONING prepared by Greco with a report of 3 permits.

PLANNING – Greco introduced Mr. King who was present for the Dollar General proposed for Ben Franklin Highway. DelPrincipe noted review of the stormwater plan. Mr. King noted not quite being ready to submit the land development and building permit application.

FIRE DEPARTMENT – no report

POLICE DEPARTMENT – 84 incidents for May 2023

Yeropoli asked Greco for any **CORRESPONDENCES/ANNOUNCEMENTS** in which Greco noted the pool is schedule to be open on June 13th. Resident Jim Buchanan inquired about increased prices for nonresidents.

Yeropoli asked for any **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**. Nothing required discussion or action.

Yeropoli began **NEW BUSINESS** in which DelPrincipe noted bids for the paving for the **RESOLUTION 2023 – 01 LAWRENCE COUNTY LIQUID FUELS GRANTS (#1)** of \$50K. Greco

noted 1 had been received in a timely manner. DelPrincipe opened and read the bid from Youngblood Paving, Inc. that all was intact to include a 10% bond. The base bid was for \$129,729 and then additional tar and chip for \$35,478 for a total of \$165,147. Yeropoli made a **MOTION** which was seconded by Pezzuolo and a vote of all in favor.

ANNUAL RESOLUTION 2023 – 02 MMO FOR NON UNION POLICE Yeropoli made a motion which Pezzuolo seconded and a vote of all in favor.

ANNUAL RESOLUTION 2023 – 03 MMO FOR UNION EMPLOYEES Yeropoli made a motion which Pezzuolo seconded and a vote of all in favor.

RESOLUTION 2023 – 04 LAWRENCE COUNTY LIQUID FUELS GRANTS (#2) Yeropoli made a motion which Sackin seconded with a vote of all in favor to apply for funds for a second round of county grant funds pending the available funds in the paving budget to apply for paving needs on Graham Road. DelPrincipe will continue to work on these grant applications and requirements. The deadline to apply for this second grant is June 30th.

Yeropoli asked for further discussion, complaints, comments. Resident Lee Hampson asked for an update on Sankey Run Road which he continues to monitor with concern. Nothing has been done thus far. Sackin noted the area being too flat to install a pipe. Yeropoli instructed Sackin to take care of this ASAP. Sackin noted millings being available for \$1/ton. Pezzuolo stated to purchase 1,500 ton and his company will donate the hauling. Yeropoli again noted to do this ASAP.

Resident Ed Klamer asked for an update on Quarry Road being closed. Yeropoli noted it will be done soon. Pezzuolo noted a gate will be put in place with a key being given to those land owners needed to access their property and a turn around point to be established as well.

Yeropoli noted the **NEXT MEETING** is on Tuesday, July 11, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.

Yeropoli asked if anything further needed to be address by those in attendance

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
