MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON AUGUST 12, 2025

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, August 12, 2025 at approximately 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116. The Meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present: Gary Pezzuolo, Mark Sackin and Vito Yeropoli was present. Also, present: Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, Solicitor's Louis Perrotta, Esq., and Officer Alfred DeCarbo.

The residents and supervisors welcomed back Yeropoli as he was attending for the first time since having his liver transplant. Pezzuolo asked for guest speakers or anyone with comments, complaints – there were none.

Greco gave the **BUILDING PERMIT/ZONING REPORT** of an addition, demolition and a solar panels. There was no **PLANNING** report. There was no **FIRE DEPARTMENT** report. Officer DeCarbo gave a **POLICE REPORT** with 89 calls for the month of June.

Pezzuolo asked Greco for **ANNOUNCEMENTS** in which she had none. Pezzuolo noted no **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**.
