MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JANUARY 5, 2026

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their annual reorganizational meeting on Monday, January 5, 2026 at approximately 10:20 a.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary. Members present were Gary Pezzuolo, Mark Sackin and Vito Yeropoli. The Township's Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe and Solicitor Louis M. Perrotta were also present along with Police Chief Robert Sipe.

Newly appointed Chairman Yeropoli asked for any guest speakers. Randy Peace wanted to thank the Road Crews for their work on New Year's Eve.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the December 9, 2025 final budget meeting minutes and the motion was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Yeropoli made a motion to adopt the minutes of the regular meeting minutes for December 9, 2025 which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Greco gave the **ZONING REPORT** with 4 roof top solar panels and an addition. There were **NO TOWNSHIP PLANNING REPORT**. Poncho gave the **FIRE DEPARTMENT** report with 30 calls for December and 293 for the calendar year. The **POLICE REPORT** given by Chief Sipe was 71 calls for December and 1,050 for the calendar year.

Yeropoli asked for **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** in which there was none. Next Yeropoli asked for **NEW BUSINESS** in which DelPrincipe noted the 2 sewer grants of which one is \$625K upgrades with no match. The other is in the final phases and will be closing soon.

Yeropoli expressed gratitude and recognition of the **JOHNSON CLUB** for donations of \$2,500 to the police department and \$1,000 to the fire departments.

Yeropoli then noted the **ANNUAL AUDITORS' MEETING** would be held Tuesday, January 6, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. The Auditor's meeting to set the compensation of the supervisors who are employed full time by the Township.

Yeropoli noted the **NEXT REGULAR MEETING** will be back to the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 6:00 p.m. for the calendar year 2026 starting with February 10, 2026.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
