### **MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON FEBRUARY 11, 2025**

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their annual reorganizational meeting on Monday, February 11, 2025 at approximately 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116. The Meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

**ROLL CALL** was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Gary Pezzuolo, Mark Sackin, and Vito Yeropoli. Also, present was Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, Attorney Kyle McCree, and Office Al DeCarbo.

Chairman Pezzuolo asked for any guest speakers. Candidates for County Judge present were Larry Keith and Jonathan Miller who both addresses the group and gave personal background and community goals for the upcoming election.

Pezzuolo made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the January 6, 2025 reorganizational meeting which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor. Sackin made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the regular meeting on January 6, 2025 which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Sackin made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the Annual Auditor's meeting on January 7, 2025 which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Pezzuolo made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.

Sackin made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.

Greco gave the **ZONING REPORT** of 3 solar panel permits and 1 demollition permit. Greco also noted for **PLANNING** a meeting would be needed for 2 subdivisions next month. No **FIRE DEPARTMENT** report was given. **POLICE REPORT** by Officer DeCarbo was 98 calls for January.

Pezzuolo asked Greco for **ANNOUNCEMENTS** in which she deferred to Sackin for the **ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN UP** set for April 21 – May 3, 2025 Monday thru Saturday.

Yeropoli noted due to the extreme cold weather the sewer plant had some large repairs which until put into place resulted in a smell. Resident Roberta Penwell noted the same occurred in Bessemer.

Pezzuolo noted nothing was needed for **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** or **NEW BUSINESS**.

Pezzuolo opened the meeting back up to the public. Ms. Penwell asked if any chance for an increased monthly flat sewer service rate. Yeropoli noted not at this time that the department keeps seeking and applying for grants which thus far have been awarded.

Yeropoli also noted he would be running again for Township Supervisor in the upcoming election and would appreciate everyone's vote.

Greco noted vast overspending on winter road materials with many of the invoices not yet been received; but, are of concern for annual cash flow.

Pezzuolo noted the **NEXT REGULAR MEETING** will be March 11, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.

Pezzuolo made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m..
