MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON MARCH 17, 2026

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, March 17, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

Chairman Vito Yeropoli called the meeting to order by all reciting the **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG**.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary. Members present were Mark Sackin, Gary Pezzuolo and Vito Yeropoli. The Township's Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe and Solicitor Louis M. Perrotta were also present along with Police Officer Jeremy DeWitt.

Chairman Yeropoli asked for any guest speakers. Resident Gary Heighzenrieter of Butch Circle asked of paving in his area to include Erskine Quarry Road. Yeropoli commented on paving budget could be effected by this year's harsh winter months and increased costs. Resident Robert Dale added that Cade Paving sells millings at \$100/ton. Mr. Heighzenreiter next commented on culvert being needed because of water. DelPrincipe and Sackin discuss with his observation that the culvert needs to be 4 foot deeper.

Resident Jill Bissett reported that she finally has some resolution with her neighbor's dogs barking. She also wanted to know more information on the deed restrictions for Baird Road and Route 422. Yeropoli commented the area is not zoned Industrial. Bissett asked if data center going in on that property. Yeropoli said no. Bissett offered to share information from a cousin in Virginia.

Resident Margis Woods inquired of Spring Clean Up to which Sackin mentioned it being helpful if loose items could be bagged.

Resident Randy Peace asked of the 224 Bridge or part of Route 224 to be renamed for Ed Mills. Pezzuolo noted that both are state owned. Peace then suggested Jackson Street. Perrotta mentioned street names are by ordinance and the 911 Center. He suggested reaching out to State Representatives.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the February 10, 2026 regular meeting in which his motion seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since last month's meeting which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since last month's meeting which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Greco gave the **ZONING REPORT** with an addition, a single family home, and a commercial storage facility. Sackin gave the **TOWNSHIP PLANNING REPORT** which was to review the **BAUM LOT CONSOLIDATION** which was approved by Planning. Yeropoli made a **MOTION** to approve the

consolidation which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.. There was no **FIRE DEPARTMENT** report. The **POLICE REPORT** given by Officer DeWitt in which he noted 72 traffic citations and 72 calls for February 2026.

Yeropoli asked Greco for any **ANNOUNCEMENTS/CORRESPONDENCES** in which she noted the Annual Spring Clean Up schedule by Sackin for April 20 – May 2, 2026. And, the annual County Tax Outreach to be in the building on April 27th 10:00 a.m. – Noon.

Yeropoli asked for **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** in which DelPrincipe noted the County CDBG Prebid meeting on Monday, March 23rd starting at 9:30 a.m. at the township building. This is for Rich Avenue paving which is 100% paid for by a grant. The award will be announced at the next meeting, April 14th.

Next, Yeropoli asked for **NEW BUSINESS** in discussion started for 2026 paving. DelPrincipe and Sackin noted Butch Circle, Erskine Quarry. Yeropoli and Sackin mentioned help to/from Pulaski Township Road Crew and modified bases. Yeropoli reminded that \$50 - \$60K of revenues were lost when the \$5 license renewal fee was removed. DelPrincipe noted the Grant application is due April 30th and a resolution would be needed at the next meeting along with a Resolution to change the application for the Local Share Grant.

Yeropoli noted the **NEXT REGULAR MEETING** will be April 14th at 6:00 p.m.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
