MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JUNE 10, 2025

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, June 10, 2025 at approximately 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116. The Meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present: Gary Pezzuolo and Mark Sackin. Vito Yeropoli was absent due to having had a liver transplant. Also, present: Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, Solicitor's Office Representative McCree, and Officer DeCarbo.

Pezzuolo asked for guest speakers or anyone with comments, complaints – there were none.

Pezzuolo made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the May 13, 2025 meeting which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Pezzuolo asked and Sackin made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Pezzuolo made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Greco gave the **BUILDING PERMIT/ZONING REPORT** of a new house, a solar panel, a storage building, and a fence. Sackin gave the **PLANNING** which was an approval of a **SUBDIVISION FOR McKENNA** which Pezzuolo made a **MOTION** which was seconded by Sackin and a vote of all in favor. Sackin noted **A LOT CONSOLIDATION FOR DOAN** for next month's planning meeting. Pezzuolo made a **MOTION** for approval contingent on the County comments and the planning committee's approval which was seconded by Sackin and a vote of all in favor. No **FIRE DEPARTMENT** report. Officer DeCarbo gave a **POLICE REPORT** with 106 calls for the month of May.

Pezzuolo asked Greco for **ANNOUNCEMENTS** in which she noted receiving communication from the County for the paving grant amount of \$23,500 for 2025. Greco also noted the pool opening and that the township's webpage has been updated with meeting minutes. The phone system is still a work in progress pending a consultant's help on this.

Pezzuolo began **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** in which the 2025 **PAVING BID REVIEW** and opening was done by DelPrincipe. Greco had received 2 sealed bids and provided proof of the advertising for the bid process, etc. The lowest bidder was Youngblood Paving for \$70,769 which was under Protech Paving's bid of \$73,368. DelPrincipe confirmed the calculations and that all

requirements of the bid were met. Pezzuolo made a **MOTION** to accept the lowest bid which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Pezzuolo moved onto **NEW BUSINESS** in which DelPrincipe noted Greco had just received this morning notice of a CDBG grant which requires low income surveys. DelPrincipe also noted that the 2023 CDBG funds were still not released to the township. Discussion ensued involving Overlook Drive to Gasperoni, Martin Kelly Spears Road and Johnson Circle.

Sackin then noted that from last month's meeting, the residents' concerns on Butch Circle has been addressed and taken care of. A catch basin and pipe were installed.

Pezzuolo opened the meeting back up to the public. Lee Hampson requested road materials be added to Sankey Run Road. What was done 2 years ago has lasted this long.

Pezzuolo noted the **NEXT REGULAR MEETING** will be July 8, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.

Pezzuolo asked for a motion to **ADJOURN** which was made by Sackin and seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
