### MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JUNE 11, 2024

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, June 11, 2024 at approximately 6:04 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

**ROLL CALL** was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Mark Sackin, Gary Pezzuolo, and Vito Yeropoli. Also present were Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, and Solicitor Louis Perrotta.

Chairman Pezzuolo asked for any guest speakers. Joe Poalini was present from the Mahoning Sportsmans Association to make a donation of \$1,000 to the police department. The club recently rented all 3 park pavilions for a fundraiser and wanted to show their appreciation with this donation as well as giving back the \$150 clean up refunds to the Township. Pezzuolo asked Greco to prepare and send a thank you letter to the Association.

Pezzuolo asked for a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the May 14, 2024 which was made by Sackin and seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Pezzuolo asked for a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was made by Sackin, seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Pezzuolo made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Greco gave the report for Township **ZONING** which there was only 1 for an inground pool. Greco also gave the report for **PLANNING** in which a meeting was held to approve subdivision for Keystone Properties and Butch along with the Perret property. No report was given for the **FIRE DEPARTMENT**. No report was given for the **POLICE DEPARTMENT**.

Further for **PLANNING** Sackin reported long time member Dave Rodgers is not in good health and may no longer be able to serve. Pezzuolo made a **MOTION** to add Roberta Penwell to the committee which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor. It was noted another vacancy may need to be filled.

Pezzuolo asked Greco for any **ANNOUNCEMENTS and CORRESPONDENCES** in which Greco noted the pool would open on Thursday, June 13, 2024 and hours are Tuesday thru Sunday Noon to 7:00 p.m.

Pezzuolo asked for any **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** in which there was none. Pezzuolo noted under **NEW BUSINESS** bids were received for **2024 PAVING**. DelPrincipe opened the 2 bids in which Russell Standard and Youngblood Paving submitted. Both completed all requirements and Youngblood Paving was the lower bid with a total base bid of \$142,545.47 plus an option bid of \$12,249.42 giving a total of \$154,794.89 for paving parts of Mohawk School Road and Evergreen

Road. The 2024 paving budget was approved at \$125K in addition to 2024 County Liquid Fuels Grant funds of \$22K leaving a deficit of just under \$5K which Greco noted would be paid from the general fund.

Pezzuolo opened the meeting back to the residents for discussion. There was none.

Pezzuolo noted the **NEXT REGULAR MEETING** will be 6:00 p.m. – July 9, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.

At 6:20 p.m., Pezzuolo made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.
