MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON JULY 11, 2023

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, July 11, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4583 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

Chairman Vito Yeropoli asked everyone present to recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Gary Pezzuolo and Vito Yeropoli. Also, present were Solicitor Lou Perrotta, Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, and Officer Scott Hedland. Absent was Mark Sackin due to a medical procedure.

Yeropoli asked for any guest speakers. Resident Lee Hampson question why still no action on repairing and improving Sankey Run Road. He noted having sent letter, pictures, attending meetings. Yeropoli responded that Mark Sackin was not available. Pezzuolo noted it will be taken care of immediately. Yeropoli agreed to get it done.

Pezzuolo brought up the millings from the state. Yeropoli noted as again from last meeting to get them ASAP. Pezzuolo noted again to Hampson the road crew would be out the next morning. Hampson thank him and asked that all realize it is 1/10th of a mile, not a bridge; and he's been waiting for 7 months.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the June 13, 2023 meeting minutes and the motion was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

TOWNSHIP REPORTS were given as follows:

ZONING prepared by Greco with a report of 4 permits.

PLANNING – update on Dollar General – land development is done and building permit is next. Attorney Perrotta noted being in touch with Waltz Consultants for the Holding Tank Agreement and that will be signed next. No resolution needed for this step.

FIRE DEPARTMENT – no report

POLICE DEPARTMENT – 143 incidents for June 2023

Yeropoli asked Greco for any **CORRESPONDENCES/ANNOUNCEMENTS** in which Greco noted the County Commissioner were to meet at the Township the next morning, 11:30am to 1:00 p.m.

Yeropoli asked for any **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**. Nothing required discussion or action. Gregg noted continued work on the 2nd County Liquid Fuels grant of \$50K with a \$10K match from township to be directed towards Graham Road. More should be available on this by the next meeting. Gregg also noted more CDBG grant funds being sought and residents of Rich Avenue being asked to supply information as required.

Pezzuolo noted Youngblood Paving to begin work mid to end of September.

Yeropoli began **NEW BUSINESS** in which Attorney Perrotta noted Mr. and Mrs. Dunacan having address issues with 911 for Tilly Lane. He noted the township is not required to change the sign and that the 911 issue needs to be resolved before any action to move the signs.

Yeropoli asked for further discussion, complaints, comments. Resident Ed Klamer asked Officer Hedland how many accidents have been on Quarry Road this Summer. Hedland answered none. Landowner Marvin McBride introduced himself and has concerns with access to get in to hunt, mow grass, etc. Pezzuolo noted keys to the gate will be issued to McBride and other landowners on Quarry Road once the gate is in place. Pezzuolo noted a trespassing fine will be issued to those non landowners. Mr. McBride offered his assistance in any way.

Yeropoli noted the **NEXT MEETING** is on Tuesday, July 11, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.

Yeropoli asked if anything further needed to be address by those in attendance

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
