MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON AUGUST 8, 2023

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, August 8, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4583 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

Chairman Vito Yeropoli asked everyone present to recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Gary Pezzuolo, Mark Sackin, and Vito Yeropoli. Also, present were Solicitor Louis Perrotta, Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, and Officer Scott Hedland.
