MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2024

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, September 10, 2024 at approximately 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Mark Sackin, Gary Pezzuolo, and Vito Yeropoli. Also present were Police Sargent Brian Magliocca, Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, and Solicitor Louis Perrotta.

Chairman Pezzuolo asked for any guest speakers. Resident Jill Bissett asked when the Evergreen Road paving project might begin in which Pezzuolo noted soon, by Fall. Ms. Bissett also noted a truck sign was gone on the road; and had questions about property boundaries which Office Magliocca noted was a private/civil matter.

Resident Susan Buchanan expressed concerns with the truck traffic on Graham Road. Sackin noted a new home being built so likely the cause.

Pezzuolo once again asked for any speaker. There were none.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the August 13, 2024 which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. Pezzuolo made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor. Sackin made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Greco gave the report for Township **ZONING** which there was none. Sackin and Roberta Penwell gave the report for **PLANNING** in which a meeting is needed for to approve **SUBDIVISION FOR SKY KING/LINDY PAVING**. The county comments were received and all was approved last month pending this review.

No report was given for the **FIRE DEPARTMENT**.

No report was given for the **POLICE DEPARTMENT** as Magliocca noted he had not planned on attending the meeting. Yeropoli and Greco discussed the police budget for 2024 which has changed when a full time office left to work elsewhere. Greco updated as requested that the police budget for 2024 was reduced to \$300K and the police may end the year under budget due to part time staffing issues. With that being said, Greco noted that a new copier was needed for both the police and the front offices. She has been making copies, printouts and sending faxes from her private office for over 2 months. Pezzuolo made a **MOTION to purchase NEW MULTIFUNCTION MACHINES** which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Pezzuolo asked Greco for any **ANNOUNCEMENTS and CORRESPONDENCES** in which Greco noted the pool was closed for the season.

Pezzuolo asked for any **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** in which DelPrincipe noted the final inspection was pending for the Park Grant which should allow the final draw to be approximately \$35,000.

Pezzuolo noted under **NEW BUSINESS** that Solicitor Perrotta had started negotiations with the Teamsters Union for the next bargaining contract. Also, DelPrincipe noted some grants coming available to include the Local Share Gaming Grant which would be applied for soon in October/November.

Pezzuolo opened the meeting back to the residents for discussion. There was none.

Pezzuolo noted the **NEXT REGULAR MEETING** will be 6:00 p.m. – October 8, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.

At 6:23 p.m., Pezzuolo made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.
