MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 12, 2023

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, September 12, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4583 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

Chairman Vito Yeropoli asked everyone present to recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Gary Pezzuolo, Mark Sackin, and Vito Yeropoli. Also, present were Solicitor Louis Perrotta, Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, and Officer Scott Hedland.

Yeropoli asked for any guest speakers. Resident Jill Bissett thanked the road crew for the work on Graham Road.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the August 8, 2023 meeting minutes and the motion was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting. The motion was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.

Yeropoli asked Greco for any **ANNOUNCEMENT/CORRESPONDENCES** Greco noted neighboring municipalities reach out and most are having Trick or Treat hours on Halloween evening this year. 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. are the most common. The supervisors agreed to these hours.

Yeropoli asked for any **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**. There was none.

Yeropoli began **NEW BUSINESS** in which Yeropoli moved onto the next 2 items which are annual items with regards to the union and police employees' pension plans and employer (100%) with employee (0%) contributions up to 5% of regular wages, no overtime. The township received state aid towards these contributions. **RESOLUTION 2023 – 05 MINIMUM MUNICIPAL OBLIGATION (MMO) FOR UNION EMPLOYEES** Yeropoli made a **MOTION** which was seconded by

Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. **RESOLUTION 2023 – 06 MINIMUM MUNICIPAL OBLIGATION (MMO) FOR NONUNION EMPLOYEES** Yeropoli made a **MOTION** which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Greco will pass these resolutions onto the Commonwealth as the state aid typically is received in November each year.

Yeropoli asked for further discussion, complaints, comments – there were none.

Yeropoli noted the **NEXT MEETING** is on Tuesday, October 10, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.

Yeropoli asked if anything further needed to be address by those in attendance

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:18 p.m.
