### MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON NOVEMBER 12, 2024

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, November 12, 2024 at approximately 6:00 p.m. immediately following the 2025 preliminary budget meeting in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

**ROLL CALL** was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Mark Sackin, Gary Pezzuolo, and Vito Yeropoli; along with Township Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, Township Solicitor Louis Perrotta, Police Officers DeCarbo and DeWitt.

Chairman Pezzuolo asked for any guest speakers – there were none.

**MINUTES** of the October 8, 2024 monthly meeting were not available for the public and Greco noted they would be at the next monthly meeting. Pezzuolo made a motion to adopt them pursuant to Greco providing the copies. Yeropoli seconded the motion and a vote of all in favor. Sackin made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor. Pezzuolo made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.

Pezzuolo asked Greco for any **ANNOUNCEMENTS and CORRESPONDENCES** in which Greco noted as in other years the Sweet Pea Patch asked if the Township building could be an emergency evacuation site for their daycare. The supervisors were all in agreement with this.

Greco gave the report for Township **ZONING** which there were permits issued for 2 fences, a wheelchair ramp, a shed, and an addition. Sackin noted there is nothing for **PLANNING**. Fire Chief Exposito noted 26 calls for October for a YTD total of 295. He also noted the ban on burning in effect statewide thru December 6, 2024. Officer DeCarbo gave the **POLICE DEPARTMENT** report with 73 calls for the month of October.

Office DeWitt was introduced and Yeropoli made a **MOTION TO HIRE DEWITT as a PART TIME OFFICER** which was seconded by Pezzuolo and a vote of all in favor. This was an agenda item under new business.

Pezzuolo asked for any **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** in which Perrotta noted ongoing negotiations with Teamsters for the union employees' contract.

Pezzuolo asked for **NEW BUSINESS** in which DelPrincipe needing the **RESOLUTION 2024 – 02 STATEWIDE LOCAL GAMING GRANT** with an application deadline of November 30, 2024 for sewer plant upgrades for up to \$1 million with no match required. Yeropoli made the motion which was seconded by Pezzuolo and a vote of all in favor

Pezzuolo asked for other new business. Sackin noted that at next month's meeting an employee cell phone policy will be reviewed and approval requested.

Pezzuolo opened the meeting back to the residents for discussion. Police Chaplin Jim Ferris was introduced and thanked.

Pezzuolo noted **NEXT MEETINGS** are as noted last month: The FINAL BUDGET MEETING will begin at 5:45 p.m. on December 10, 2024 followed by the regular meeting; and then the annual reorganizational meeting would be on Thurs, January 3 at 9:00 a.m. followed by the regular meeting.

At 6:12 p.m., Yeropoli made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor.
