MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON OCTOBER 14, 2025

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, October 14, 2025 at approximately 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116. The Meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present: Gary Pezzuolo, Mark Sackin and Vito Yeropoli was present. Also, present: Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, Solicitor's Louis Perrotta, Esq., and Officer Jeremy DeWitt.

Pezzuolo asked for any guests wanting to speak. Resident Virginia Phillips spoke of appreciation to supervisors and road crew for paving efforts. She also asked residents to help contribute to the FD Campbell Library fund drive for new windows.

Sackin made a motion to **ADOPT THE MINUTES** of the August 12, 2025 meeting which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Yeropoli made a motion to **PAY THE BILLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. Pezzuolo made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.

Greco gave the **BUILDING PERMIT/ZONING REPORT** of which there were 3 solar permits issued. Sackin noted for the **PLANNING** report a meeting will be needed for the Ratvasky Subdivision and the Land Development Plan for Lindy Paving. There was no **FIRE DEPARTMENT** report. Officer DeWitt gave the **POLICE REPORT** of 93 calls for the month of September.

Pezzuolo asked Greco for **ANNOUNCEMENTS** in which she noted Trick or Treat hours to align with Bessemer and North Beaver would be on Halloween 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. and Township offices would be closed on Election Day which is November 4, 2025.

Pezzuolo asked for **UNFINISHED BUSINESS** in which Solicitor Perrotta noted the need to advertise for possible zoning change amendment. Yeropoli made a **MOTION** which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Sackin noted that paving by Youngblood finished today.

Pezzuolo asked for **NEW BUSINESS** and DelPrincipe noted the need at next meeting for a resolution for a grant for the sewer plant.

Pezzuolo opened the meeting back up to the public and there was none.

Pezzuolo noted the **NEXT REGULAR MEETING** will be October 14, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. and prior to that meeting at 5:45 p.m. would be the preliminary budget meeting for calendar year 2026.

Yeropoli made a motion to **ADJOURN** which was seconded by Sackin with a vote of all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:08 p.m.
