MINUTES OF THE PROPOSED BUDGET MEETING ON NOVEMBER 12, 2024

The Mahoning Township Supervisors met at the Mahoning Township Municipal Building on Tuesday November 12, 2024 at 5:45 p.m.. for their annual proposed budget meeting. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pezzuolo who asked everyone present to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Members present were: Mark Sackin, Gary Pezzuolo, and Vito Yeropoli. Also present were Solicitor Lou Perrotta, and Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe

Pezzuolo asked Greco to review the preliminary budget for calendar year 2025. **CONFIRMATION OF ADVERTISEMENT** was recorded by Greco. Greco noted no increase in taxes would be necessary for 2025. She also noted the benefits of the increase to hydrant and light taxes for 2024 and those 2 funds no longer needed transfers from the general fund to cover the monthly water and electric charges. The monies have not yet been returned to the general fund from past years' deficits, however. Greco stated the proposed budget will be available for review by the public before the budget adoption meeting scheduled for Tuesday, December 10, 2024 at 5:45 p.m.

Pezzuolo noted 1 mill from the real estate taxes remains restricted for annual paving. It would be anticipated that \$125K be spent on paving in 2025.

Greco further noted negotiations of the Teamsters contract are ongoing and Solicitor Perotta is assisting in this subject matter.

Pezzuolo asked for any comments to this information. None were made. Pezzuolo made a **MOTION** to accept the preliminary budget information. The motion was seconded by Sackin which a vote of all in favor.

Sackin made a **MOTION** to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Pezzuolo which a vote of all in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
