### **MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING ON DECEMBER 9, 2025**

The Mahoning Township Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at approximately 6:15 p.m. immediately following the 2026 final budget meeting in the meeting room of the Mahoning Township building located at 4538 West State Street, Edinburg, PA 16116.

**ROLL CALL** was taken by Jean Greco, Secretary/Treasurer. Pezzuolo once again noted that Supervisor Sackin has a family medical emergency and was not in attendance. Members present were: Gary Pezzuolo and Vito Yeropoli. Also present were Solicitor Lou Perrotta, Engineer Gregg DelPrincipe, and Police Officer Jeremy DeWitt.

Pezzuolo asked for any guest speakers – there were none.

Yeropoli made a motion to adopt the **MINUTES OF THE NOVEMBER 11, 2025 PRELIMINARY BUDGET MEETING** which was seconded by Pezzuolo with a vote of all in favor. Resident Marcy Romano pointed out a typo in the Route 224 which should be Route 422 and Greco noted the correction. Pezzuolo made a motion to adopt the **MINUTES OF THE NOVEMBER 11, 2025 REGULAR MEETING** which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.

Pezzuolo made a motion to **PAY THE PAYROLLS** as prepared by Greco since the last month's meeting which was seconded by Yeropoli with a vote of all in favor.
